Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to UF female undergraduate majors in anthropology for archaeological field schools for summer 2011.

This memorial scholarship honors Dr. Patricia S. Essenpreis (Ph.D. Harvard 1982) who was on the faculty of the University of Florida. She was well known for her work on the 2000-year old Fort Ancient site in Ohio where she conducted field schools for the Universities of Florida and Cincinnati from 1987-90.

Through this scholarship her family, friends, and colleagues continue her commitment to undergraduate education in archaeology.

One award will be given to a student attending a field school in either Florida or the Caribbean. The geographic area of the second award is open.

Please have one of your Anthropology professors (or anthropology Teaching Assistant, Teaching Associate, or Anthropology Museum Collections manager) write a **letter of recommendation** and submit their letter to you in a sealed and signed envelope. Please include this form, your statement, and letter of recommendation with the application.

Turn in this application form, your essay, and the letter of recommendation to the Anthropology Office by **4:30 pm on Friday, April 8, 2011**. Late applications will not be accepted. You can turn in your application ahead of the deadline.

Announcement of the awards will be made on Wednesday, April 13 and posted outside of the anthropology office. The award winners will be invited to attend the Anthropology Awards ceremony on Wednesday, April 20 at 3 pm.
